

Pop Art Summer Camp at the AGW 2018

Week 1: July 9-13 and Week 2: July 16-20

9 am - 4 pm recommended ages: 6 – 14 (No exceptions thank-you!)

This summer at the Art Gallery of Windsor venture into the world of Pop art! There will be something for everyone from exploring colour with painting techniques, still life drawing, and printmaking to three-dimensional clay modelling. Campers will enjoy the art of Andy Warhol and be guided through new ways to experience his art by using strategies and techniques with a variety of materials and techniques.

Each morning, campers will meet on the second floor in the art studio, a wondrous & inspiring space with tall ceilings and floor to ceiling windows overlooking our beautiful Windsor Waterfront Garden and famous Detroit River Skyline. Campers will experience daily tours of the galleries, and hands-on activities and outings to the Sculpture Park and a visit to the Chimczuk Museum while their Pop Art Exhibition is installed in the 2nd Floor Studio.

WEEK 1 – JULY 9-13

Monday: Food Matters

Inspired by the *Andy Warhol: Printed Food Matter* exhibition, with prints of food and soda labels from the 1970s and 1980's, campers will have fun creating their own pop art food print in the morning and in the afternoon design their own Andy Warhol – Four Squared inspired pop art food label or brand name logo.

Tuesday: Fast Food

Inspired by *IAIN BAXTER&: &WICHTIME* exhibition, where the artist explores the commercial relationships between art and food through bread, campers will explore the use of contemporary materials in a fast food culture when they create soft fast food sculptures out of a variety of soft materials.

Wednesday: The Sandwich Shop

Inspired by *The Contemporary Sandwich Shop*, a group exhibition showcasing eight artists working with the ideas surrounding the consumption and commodification of food through a consumer lens, campers will create miniature clay dessert food sculptures in the morning and will paint them in the afternoon.

Thursday: Paint & Nibble

Inspired by the *Andy Warhol: Printed Food Matter* exhibition, campers will all create a fun food inspired pop art painting as they nibble on fruits and veggies at a relaxing pace in the inspiring 2nd floor studio which overlooks the beautiful Windsor waterfront.

Friday: Food for Thought

Drawing inspiration from the *Still Life: 'Food' for the Eye, Mind and Body* exhibition, with images from the nineteenth to the twenty-first century from the Art Gallery of Windsor's permanent collection, campers will examine the art of still life drawings and back in the studio, complete drawing studies in coloured pencil and watercolour from life size still life displays set up in the studio in the morning. In the afternoon, campers will visit the Chimczuk Museum before their art show at 3pm. Friends & family are invited to come!

WEEK 2 – JULY 16-20

Monday: Food Patterns

Inspired by the *Andy Warhol: Printed Food Matter* exhibition, with prints of food and soda labels from the 1970s and 1980's, campers will have fun using fruit and vegetable to create their own unique print series or pattern in the morning and in the afternoon create and colour a giant foam board cut out of their favourite treat!

Tuesday: The Bakery

Inspired by *IAIN BAXTER&: &WICHTIME*, where the artist explores the commercial relationships between art and food through bread, campers will explore the use of contemporary materials in a fast food culture when they create soft dessert food sculptures out of a variety of soft materials.

Wednesday: The Pop-up Shop

Inspired by *The Contemporary Sandwich Shop*, a group exhibition showcasing eight artists working with the ideas surrounding the consumption and commodification of food through a consumer lens, campers will design and create your own unique Campbell Soup Label in the morning and a restaurant sign in the afternoon.

Thursday: Paint & Nibble

Inspired by the *Andy Warhol: Printed Food Matter* exhibition, campers will create their own Andy Warhol – Four Squared inspired pop art acrylic painting as they nibble on fruits and veggies at a relaxing pace in the inspiring 2nd floor studio which overlooks the beautiful Windsor waterfront.

Friday: Food Colouring

Drawing inspiration from the *Still Life: 'Food' for the Eye, Mind and Body* exhibition, with images from the nineteenth to the twenty-first century from the Art Gallery of Windsor's permanent collection, campers will examine the art of still life drawing with life size still life displays set up for drawing studies in Charcoal, Coloured Chalk and Pastel in the morning. In the afternoon campers will visit the Chimczuk Museum before their art show. Friends & family are invited to come!
